### MPC POLISHING POWDER

#### SYMPTOM —

Marble has lost its polish, is dull and colour has faded.

#### PRESCRIPTION —

M.P.C. Polishing Powder will restore the original beauty to marble floors, using some of the same ingredients used on walls and tops at the factory.

#### DIRECTIONS —

Lightly wet the floor with clean water. Apply approximately ¼ cup of MPC on floor. Using a red pad, polish with 175 to 300 rpm floor machine. Do approximately 40 sq ft at a time in a checkerboard fashion. After making several passes, squeegee slurry back. If finish is satisfactory, wet vac and rinse with clean water and wet vac again. If not, continue polishing. Keep surrounding area wet so splatter does not etch. Stir MPC prior to use and replace lid immediately.

#### NOTE —

If the surface is heavily worn with foot traffic, refinishing with abrasives may be required.

#### CAUTION —

Contains acid. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Keep out of reach of children. Always test in an inconspicuous area prior to general use. Protect all acid sensitive surfaces.
